- All entries must be original work
- All entries must use no smaller than 12 point font in Times New Roman or Comic Sans
- Be sure to save your file. Winners will be asked to email their entry to the chairperson.
- Short story entry may range from a minimum of 300 words to no more than 800 words.
- Poem entry will consist of a single poem, any style, from a minimum of 25 words to no more than 150 words
- Entries must **not** include graphics
- Each entry must include a completed cover sheet signed by the student author, parent, and sponsoring teacher.

Students who are interested in participating must submit their entries by **Monday**, **December 19th**. <u>Important Math Information for Parents of 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders</u>: Students who are not fluent with basic multiplication and division facts are at a huge disadvantage with many other aspects of math. For example, solving division

problems and working with equivalent fractions is much easier if students are able to easily access related multiplication facts. So how do we accomplish this? Flashcards are one option, but students will be more engaged and interested if we find meaningful ways for them to practice. There are a wealth of online computer games and apps for practicing basic facts. Many of them are free. The attached pdf file contains suggestions for online multiplication facts practice. The file contains live links, so you can access the game by simply clicking on the link. Feel free to contact Mrs. Akers (Math Support Teacher) or your child's math teacher if you have questions about basic facts.

#### **Emergency Notifications**

#### SCHOOL HOURS

Grades K– 5 9:25a.m. – 3:55p.m. Preschool AM - 9:25 – 11:55a.m.

Students may enter the building at 9:10 am, when the bell chimes.

#### LATE ARRIVALS

Students who arrive at school after 9:25a.m. MUST be accompanied by a parent to the Main Office to be signed in before reporting to class.

#### EARLY DISMISSAL

Teachers may not dismiss students to parents/guardians. Parents/guardians must come to the Main Office, with identification, to sign out students and the office will request that the teacher send the student to the office. This procedure is for the safety of all our students. **ABSENCE POLICY** 

A parent note explaining a student's absence is required when a student is absent for any portion of the school day. Please include date(s) of absence(s). When a student in absent 3 or more consecutive days a doctor's note is requested upon the student's return to school. **BUSES** 

Children are assigned to buses by the Pupil Transportation Office based on where they live. Lists of students who ride a particular bus are kept on record in the office. Children are not permitted to ride on another bus. If an emergency arises, please call the main office 410-880-5930.

#### WALKERS

The Crossing Guard will be on post from 8:55-9:20a.m. Please do not send your children before this time. Students will not be permitted in the building until 9:10 a.m.

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
